

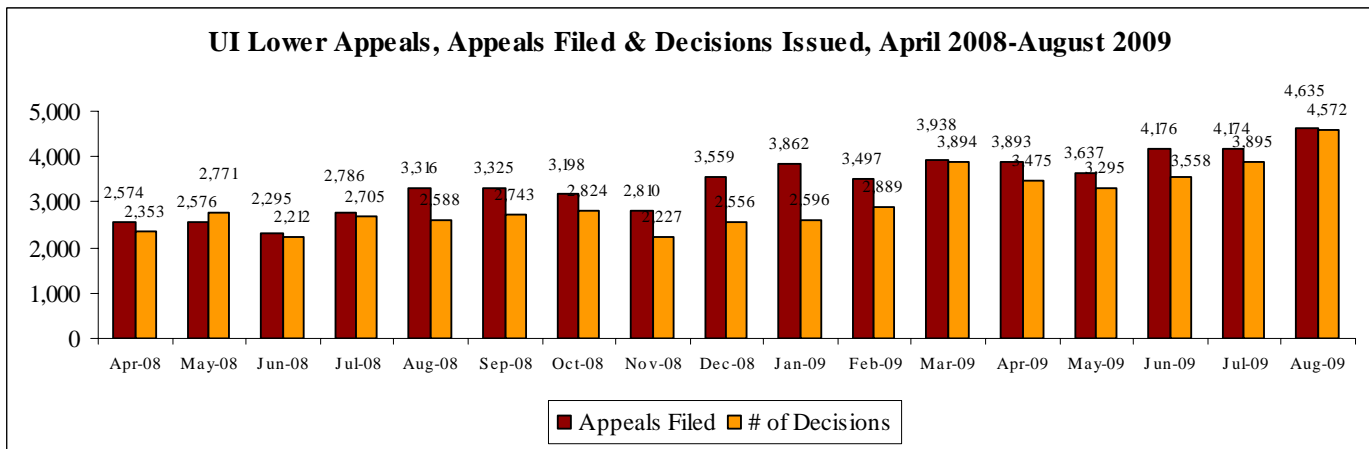

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DLLR Stat on September 08, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat.

**General Discussion**

- **Correctional Education.** Secretary Gary Maynard of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services has asked that correctional education issues continue to be discussed at DPSCS’s Division of Correction’s StateStat meetings. (Correctional education was moved under DLLR beginning July 1.)
- **Unemployment Insurance Appeals.** In the face of increasing appeals filed, unemployment insurance Lower Appeals has dramatically increased its output in the number of decisions it has issued. To further assist in this effort, Lower Appeals will be working with a core group of 15 Administrative Law Judges beginning October 1, each of whom will begin hearing 1-2 dockets of cases each day.



- **SBR Participation.** DLLR exceeded the State’s 10% goal of small business reservation participation in FY09.
