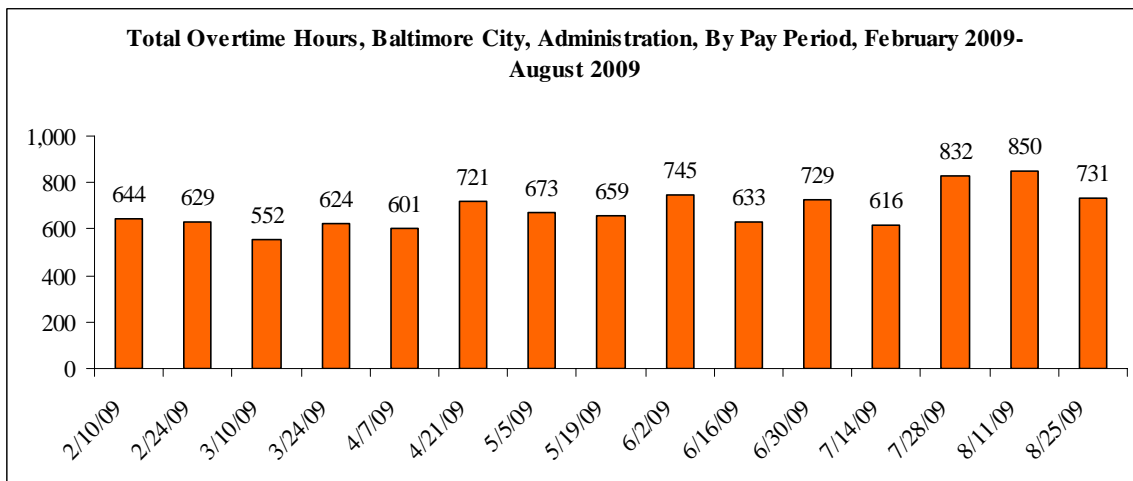

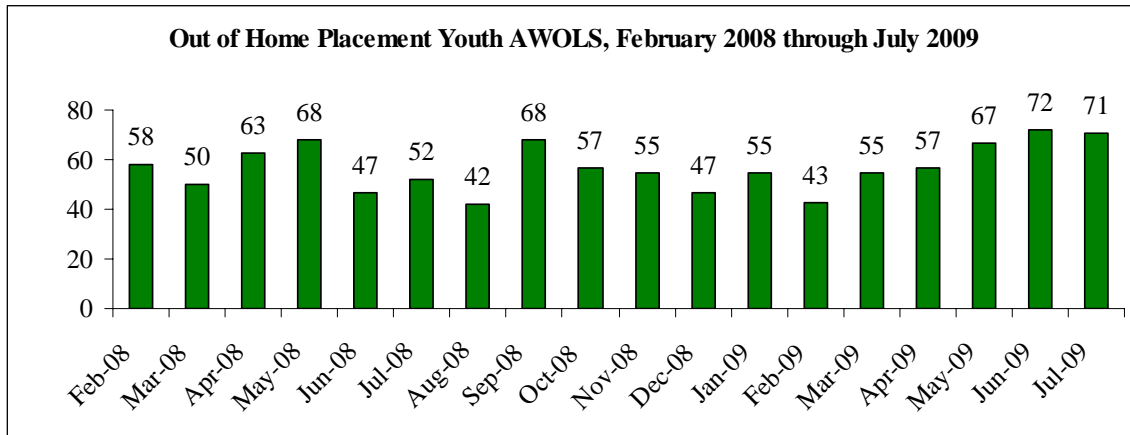
Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on September 11, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **Overtime Hours.** DJS was asked to explain why overtime hours at the Administration Level in Baltimore City were at a high rate for the month of July 2009. DJS stated in the previous StateStat meeting that transportation hours fall under Administration; thus contributing to the high number of hours. DJS was recommended to separate Transportation data from Administration data so that an analysis can be done to determine ways to lower these numbers.



- **AWOLS.** DJS was asked to discuss the increase in the number of out-of-home placement youth AWOLs in the last few months. DJS stated that several of these facilities are open-door placements and DJS is working closely with DBM to secure more locked placements.



- Eastern Point Group Home.** DJS was asked to discuss the fact that several youth at the Eastern Point group home were causing disturbances in the community of the placement. DJS reported that delinquent youth are no longer referred to this program.
