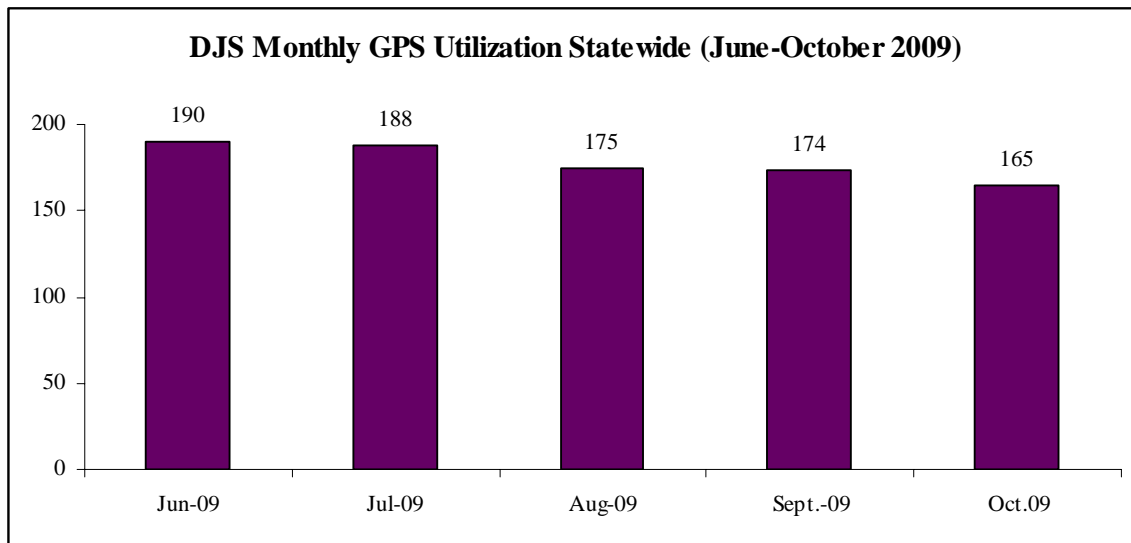

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on October 9, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

**General Discussion**

- **H1N1 Update.** DJS provided an update in reference to what steps are being taken in terms of immunizations for youth in DJS care. DJS stated that they have set-up and H1N1 hotline and more than 600 doses of H1N1 nasal vaccines have been sent out to DJS facilities. Also, more than 2,750 doses of inactivated H1N1 vaccines have been prepared for staff and youth who cannot receive the nasal vaccine.
- **GPS Utilization.** DJS discussed the utilization of GPS units and they stated that the numbers fluctuate from month-to-month.



- **VPI.** DJS was asked to discuss the reasons for the rate of VPI youth arrested in the month of August. DJS explained that the numbers are high because more youth were placed on VPI status during the month; therefore, the numbers are relative in comparison to other months.
