

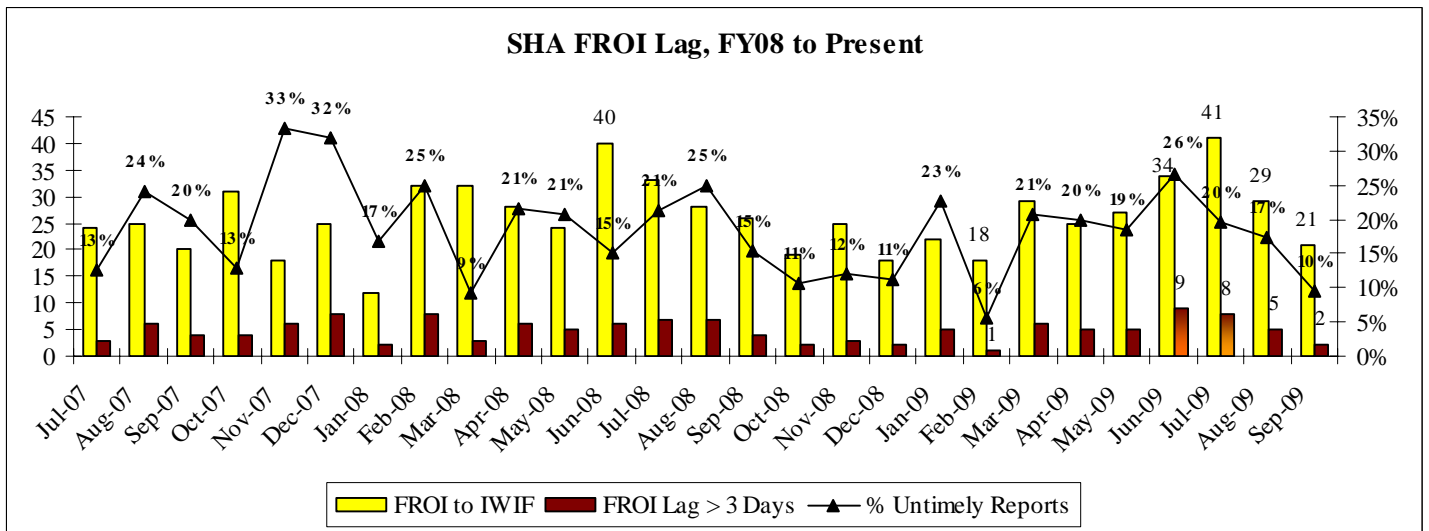

**Date of Meeting:** October 30, 2009

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the MDOT-SHA Stat on October 30, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat.

**General Discussion**

- **Street Racing.** SHA reported that it is coordinating its anti street racing efforts with the Maryland State Police. The two agencies have generated a list of racing sites where they will increase enforcement.
- **Broening Highway (Dundalk).** SHA reported that the two 40-foot sections of pipe that needed to be replaced as a direct result of the pipe rupture had been completed and that the actual road work to be completed by Baltimore City would begin the following week.
- **Monthly Maintenance Metrics.** In advance of the December StateStat meeting, SHA will complete a significant expansion of the template: tracking shop-level maintenance data on a monthly basis.
- **IWIF Reporting.** Following seasonally high reports of injury to IWIF, SHA saw significant declines in both the number reports and those that were reported untimely.



- **Snow Removal.** SHA reported that it has a new radio system with GPS capabilities that will increase the efficiency of its snow removal operation.
