General Discussion

- **Adult Services.** At a previous Stat meeting, DHR was asked to discuss be prepared to discuss adult services. At this meeting, a presentation was given highlighting exactly the types of clients who are eligible for adult services and the programs that are involved.
- **PlaceMatters.** DHR was asked to discuss their PlaceMatters goals and what they intend to do for FY10. StateStat has also asked DHR to provide real numbers, in addition to percentages, in the PlaceMatters portion of the template.
