

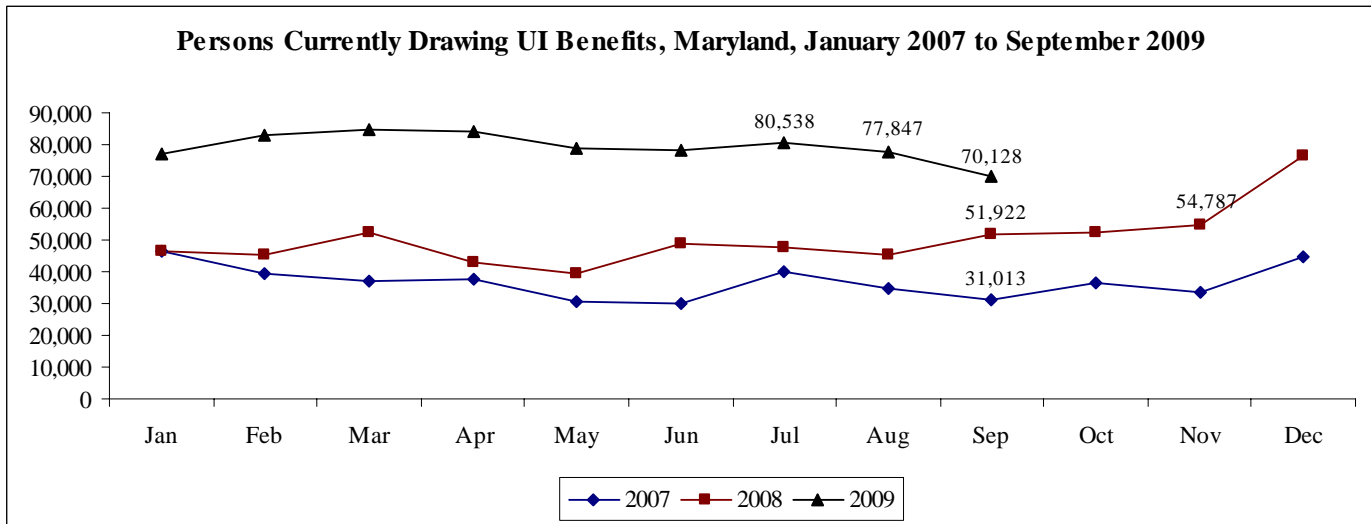
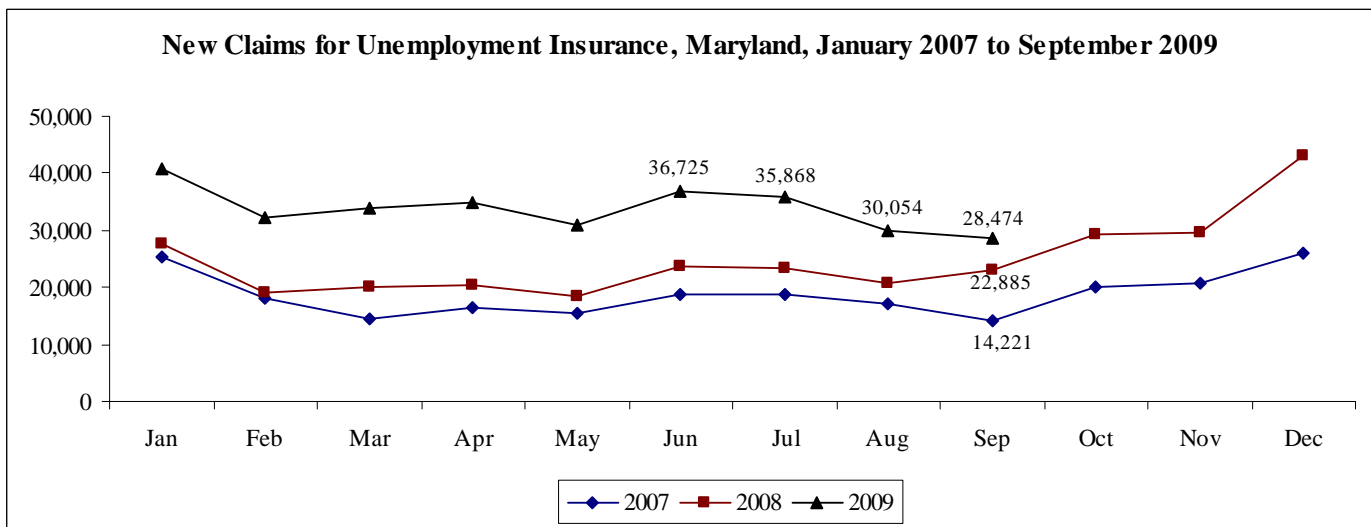

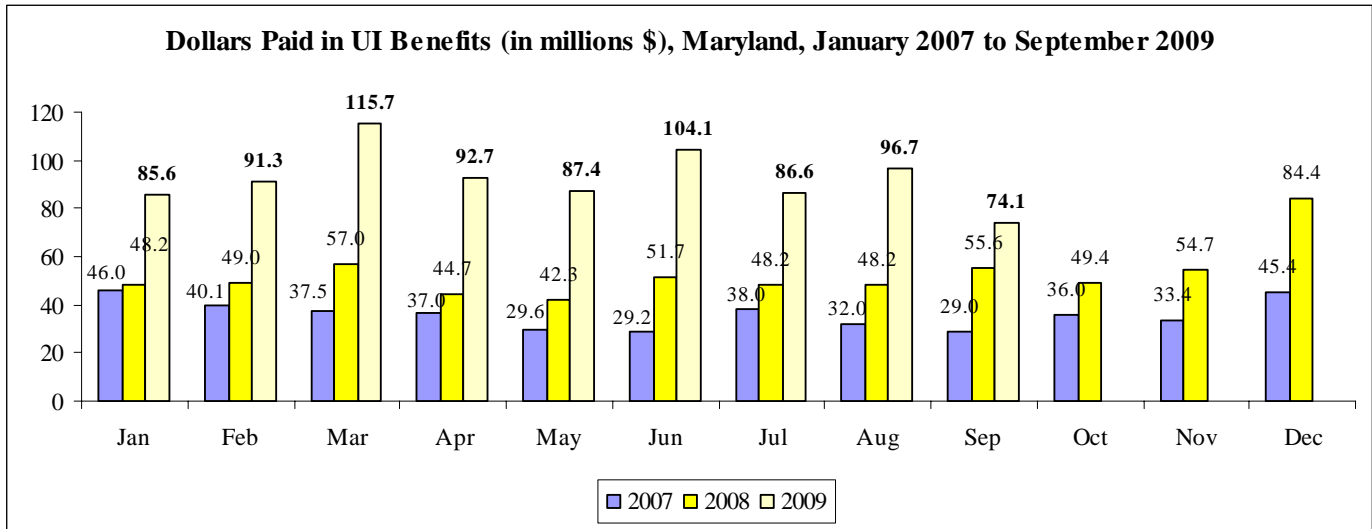

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DLLR Stat on November 12, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat.

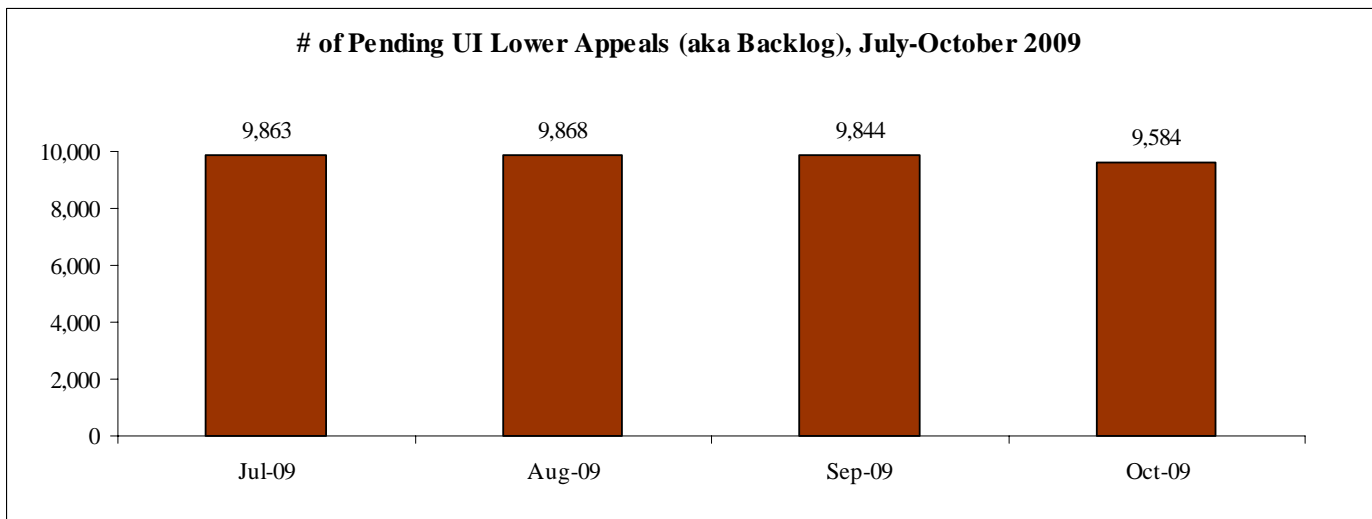
General Discussion

- **Unemployment Insurance.** In September, the number of new UI claims was at its lowest level since September 2008, and the number of individuals drawing benefits and the dollars paid out in benefits were at their lowest levels since November 2008.





- Lower Appeals Case Management.** At the October StateStat meeting, DLLR presented its management plan for eliminating the backlog of Lower Appeals cases. As the chart below demonstrates, the Department has managed to achieve a 2.9% reduction in the backlog in just two months, almost all of which came in October. The Department is also in the process of interviewing for new hearing examiners.



- Elevator Inspection Backlog.** Between April and September, DLLR achieved an 8% reduction in the backlog of elevator inspections.
