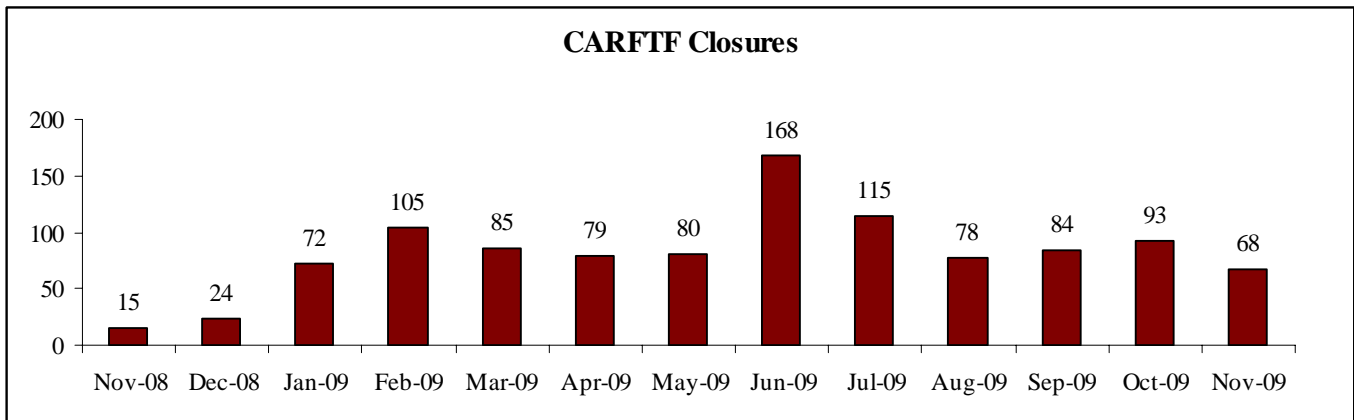
General Discussion

- **CARFTF Warrant Service.** The chart below highlights warrant service efforts by the MSP team on the Prince George’s County CARFTF task force through November 2009. The panel may note that *November* warrant service totals show *decrease* over recent months. Though MSP continues to meet warrant service targets per team member, the number of officers assigned to the Task Force decreased in November.
- In November the MSP Team on CARFTF *exceeded 1,000 warrants* served year-to-date for 2009.

November: Performance Breakdown:

- Number of Personnel This Month – 7 – 5 MSP and 2 MPD
- Closure Goal - 50.4 Warrant Closures (Based on established benchmark of 7.2 warrant closures per inv.)
- Total Closures – 68 (9.71 Warrant Closures per inv.) – MSP = 12.2 avg., MPD = 3.5 avg.
- 30 Admin. Closures – 31%
- 29 Arrest Closures – 57%
- 9 Detainer Closures – 12%

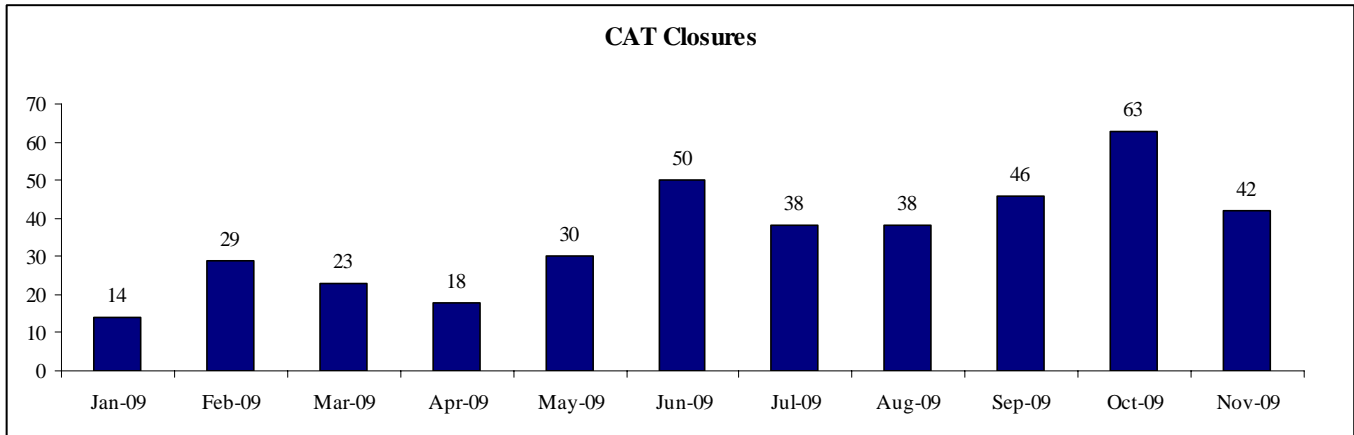


- **Baltimore Warrant Task Force (CAT).** The panel may recall that MSP has assumed a restructured role in the Baltimore Warrant Task Force, with the Department now responsible for service of warrants for Baltimore offenders who have fled or reside outside the city.

November: Performance Breakdown:

- Number of Personnel This Month – 6 – 4 MSP, 1 BPD, 1 BSO
- Closure Goal – 43.2 Warrant Closures (Based on established benchmark of 7.2 warrant closures per inv.)
- Total Closures – 42 (7 Warrant Closures per inv.) – MSP = 4.75 avg., BPD = 16 avg., BSO = 7 avg.
- 21 Admin. Closures – 50%
- 20 Arrest Closures – 48%
- 1 Detainer Closure – 2%



- **DNA Casework Backlog Reduction.** The following chart shows the backlog in DNA casework pending analysis by MSP. MSP is consistently meeting monthly targets for DNA backlog reduction as submitted to GDU towards the goal to reduce the backlog of DNA casework by 15% in CY 09.
