Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DHR Stat on January 15, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **GDU Goals.** The GDU explained to DHR the importance of DHR providing specific, level-of-effort information on the implementation of its expanded/improved FSP (food stamp program) enrollment activities. The GDU stated that they believe that these activities are intended to help drive and manage the considerable increase in FSP enrollment in the state.
- **Food Stamps.** DHR explained their continuously expanding efforts to meet the needs of those needing Expanded and Regular food stamp aid in the state. DHR went into details in reference to their corrective action plan and the extra work being done in jurisdictions where service compliance rates are declining.
