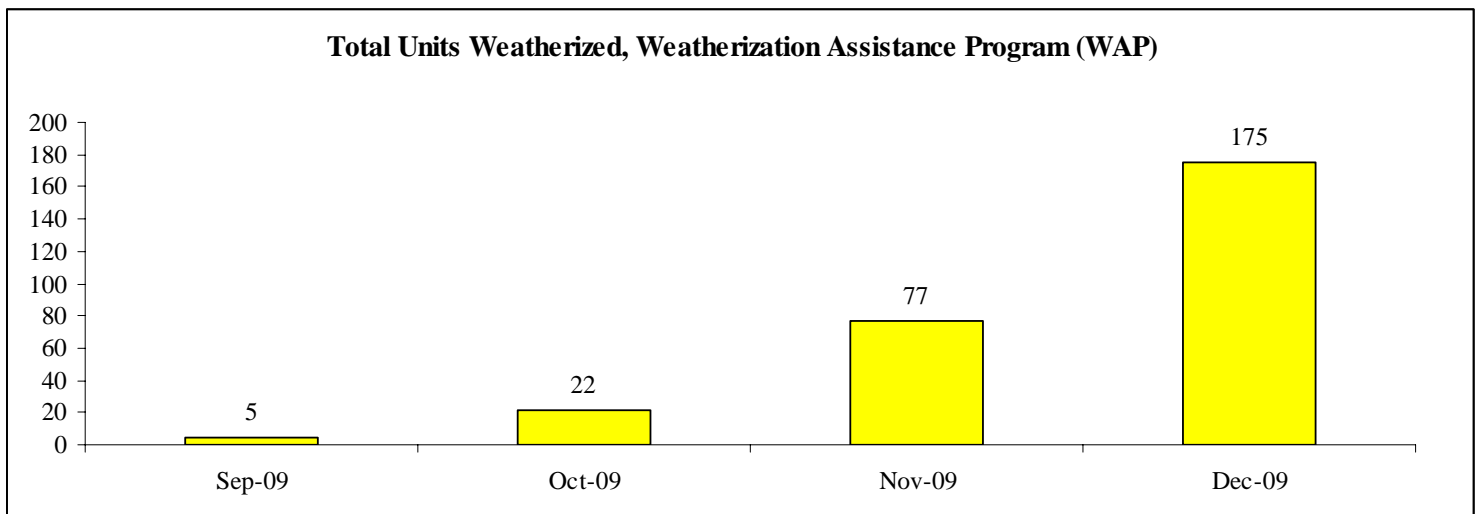

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DHCD Stat on January 26, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **New Issue Bond Program (NIBP).** DHCD discussed their collaborative efforts with the U.S. Treasury, Fannie Mae, and Freddie Mac to implement NIBP for CY2010. DHCD received a grant of \$92 million for multifamily rental development under NIBP, and will be providing a fixed interest rate in the mid-4% range for rental housing loans for 40 years.
- **Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program (EECBG).** DHCD reported that they had submitted an application to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) for a grant under the EECBG program. If the application is successful, DHCD would direct the grant money toward providing energy efficiency upgrades for single and multi-family homes, and to training local officials in enforcement of new energy codes. DHCD requested \$32 million in federal funds for the grant, and anticipates a final decision by DOE at some point in March.
- **Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP).** ARRA funded production increased significantly in December 2009, as it was reported that 175 units were weatherized through ARRA funds. DHCD reported that the production increases were caused in part by all Local Weatherization Agencies (LWA's) now operating at their full capacity. DHCD also reported that both training hours and training expenditures saw marked increases in December 2009.
