General Discussion

- **FIA Aides.** DHR discussed the roles of the FIA aides who are currently working in Baltimore City on the food stamp application backlogs in Baltimore County. The aides are working strictly on the backlog and their positions were created by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).
- **Food Stamps.** DHR gave an update on their efforts to meet the needs of those needing Expanded and Regular food stamp aid in the state. As indicated, the percentages are starting to decrease in many jurisdictions due to the fact that more citizens are in need. DHR stated that they have action plans ready for counties that are not processing applications in a timely manner.
