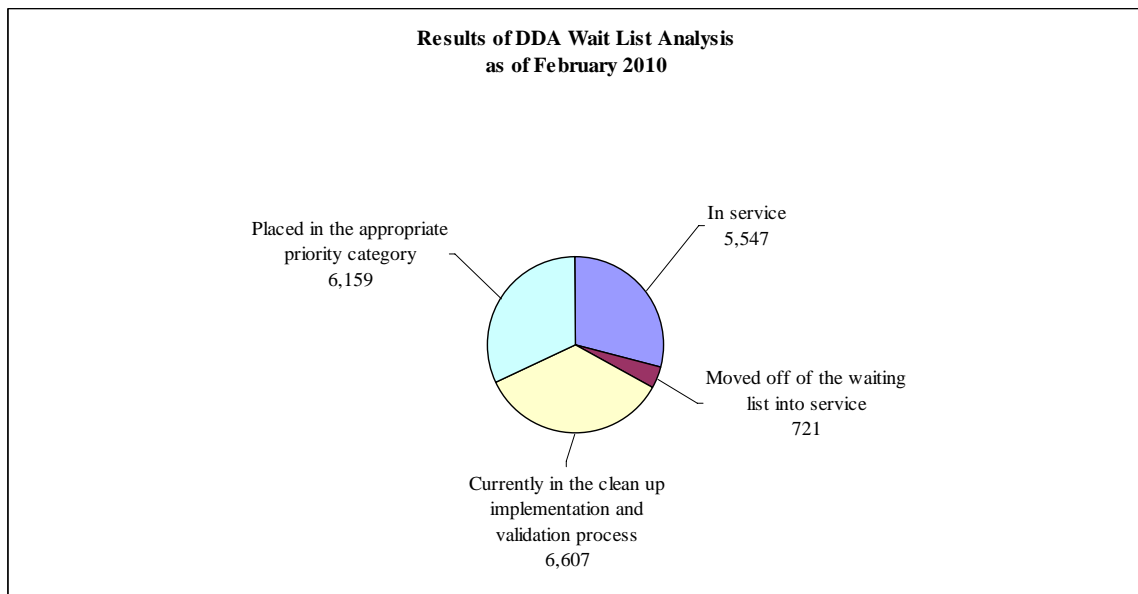

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DHMH Stat on February 16, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

### **General Discussion**

- **Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA).** DHMH provided an update on the process of assessing the needs of individuals on the DDA waiting list. The agency reported that 6,159 individuals from the waiting list have been placed in the appropriate priority category.
- Of the original waiting list, 5,547 were found to be in service at the time of the needs assessment and 721 were moved off of the waiting list into service, as shown in the chart below.



- **Breast and Cervical Cancer Issues.** The Department described the various State programs through which breast and cervical cancer screening, treatment and diagnosis are provided. DHMH described Medicaid as providing comprehensive coverage for breast and cervical cancer screening, diagnosis, and treatment as well as the full range of Medicaid services.
- Preventative services are also provided through the new Comprehensive Women's Health Services program in three pilot jurisdictions: Baltimore City, Prince George's County, and Somerset County.
