Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DHR Stat on February 26, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

### **General Discussion**

- **GDU Goals.** The Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU) asked DHR to provide specific details on the steps being taken to increase and expand food stamp program enrollment activities. The GDU also stated that DHR's *PlaceMatters* program will be monitored thoroughly because of the fact that the program has been contributing substantively towards statewide crime reduction goals.
- **Howard County FIA.** A presentation was given by staff from Howard County in reference to the ongoing efforts to process FIA applications in a timely manner. Howard County staff presented an in-depth action plan that involved such measures as using community volunteers, filling open positions rapidly, and using temporary workers to reduce the backlog of FIA applications in their jurisdiction.
