

Meeting Summary

Date of Meeting: March 11, 2010

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DLLR Stat on March 11, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- DLLR is changing the organization of the way that Unemployment Insurance (UI) overpayments are collected. The division is hiring three new individuals, utilizing an IT liaison, and using the National New Hire database to identify overpayments. USDOL has also provided DLLR with a supplemental budget to purchase software.
- DLLR and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) are making a concerted effort to begin utilizing the Federal Treasury Offset Program, in order to maximize methods by which UI overpayments are collected. Presently, DLLR utilizes the Tax Intercept program and the Central Collections Unit (CCU) within DBM to collect overpayments.
- The UI Trust Fund Modernization bill (HB 91) has gained support and is likely to pass, according to DLLR.
- As shown in the chart below, the number of boilers and pressure vessels that are more than two years past due are declining, due to concentrated effort by DLLR and continued focus on this issue by StateStat. Inspections of high risk units such as high-pressure boilers are up-to-date.
