

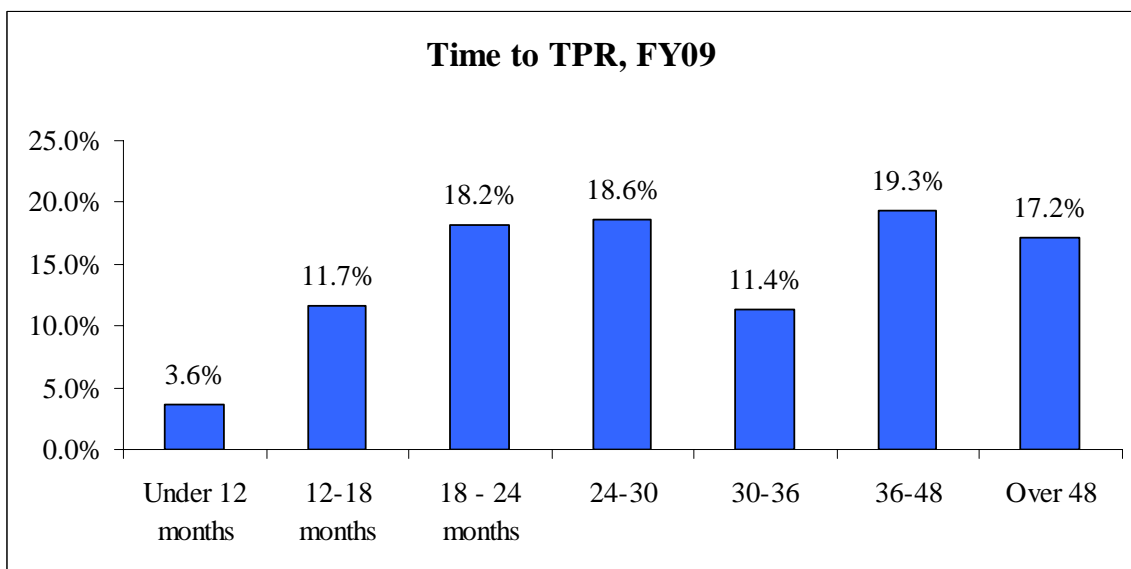
Meeting Summary

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DHR Stat on March 12, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor’s Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **GDU Goals.** The Governor’s Delivery Unit (GDU) asked DHR to explain how they play a part in CBOs receiving reimbursements from the USDA when it comes to the CBOs providing outreach for low-income households on the food stamp program.
- **TPR (Termination of Parental Rights).** DHR was asked to give an overview as to what actions are taking place to reduce the length of stay times for children who are on TPR status. DHR stated that they are working with the Citizens Review Board and local courts to quicken TPRs and/or adoption.



- **Food Stamps.** DHR provided an update on the backlogs in food stamp application processing in several jurisdictions and they report that there has been significant progress in reducing the totals. However, the totals may not show in the DHR template for another few periods.
