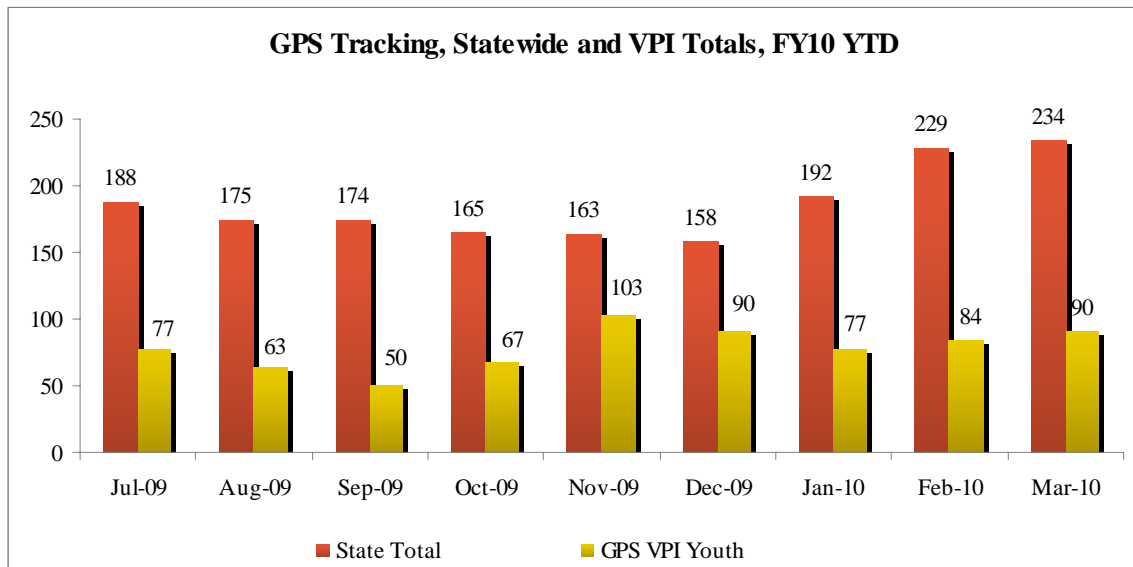

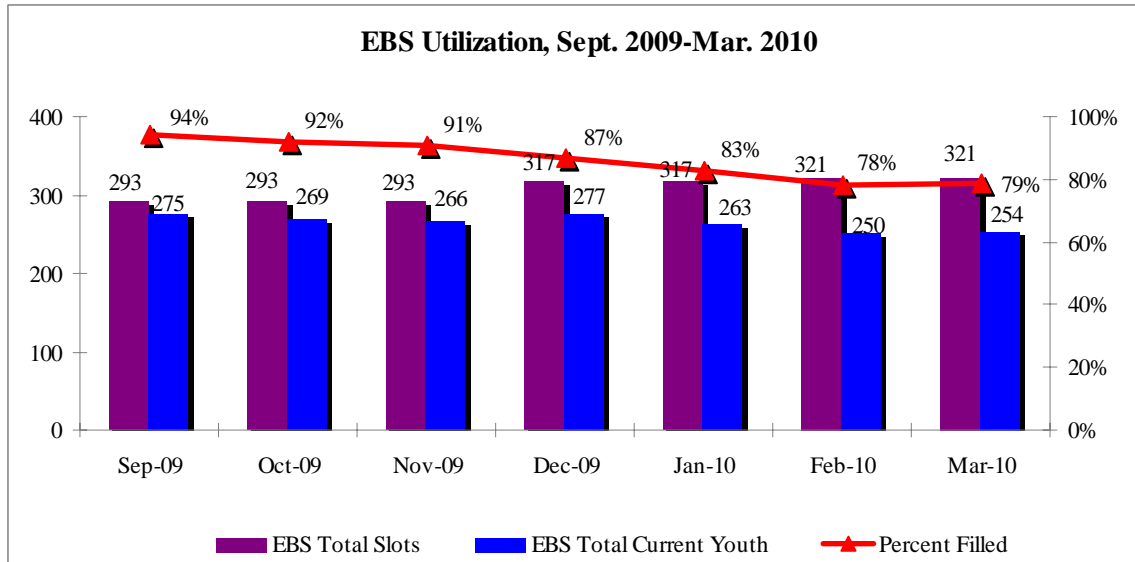
Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on March 12, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor’s Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **GPS.** DJS provided an update as to how many DJS youth are currently under GPS supervision as well as the rate of VPI youth who are on GPS. DJS also stated that all DJS youth, who happen to come under DPP supervision as well, will be placed on GPS once they have been released from detention.



- **EBS Utilization.** DJS reports that Baltimore City has a capacity for 65 MST slots and at this time, 61 of those slots have been filled. DJS also reports that a snapshot of the April totals for this year will show that more of the slots have been filled.



- Pending Placements.** DJS explained that the reason for the increase in the pending placement population is due to the fact that more youth are in need of intensive services at this time. This increase has caused the wait time to be a bit longer for these youth to be placed. However, the average length of stay for pending placement releases was at its lowest point in FY09 since FY05.
