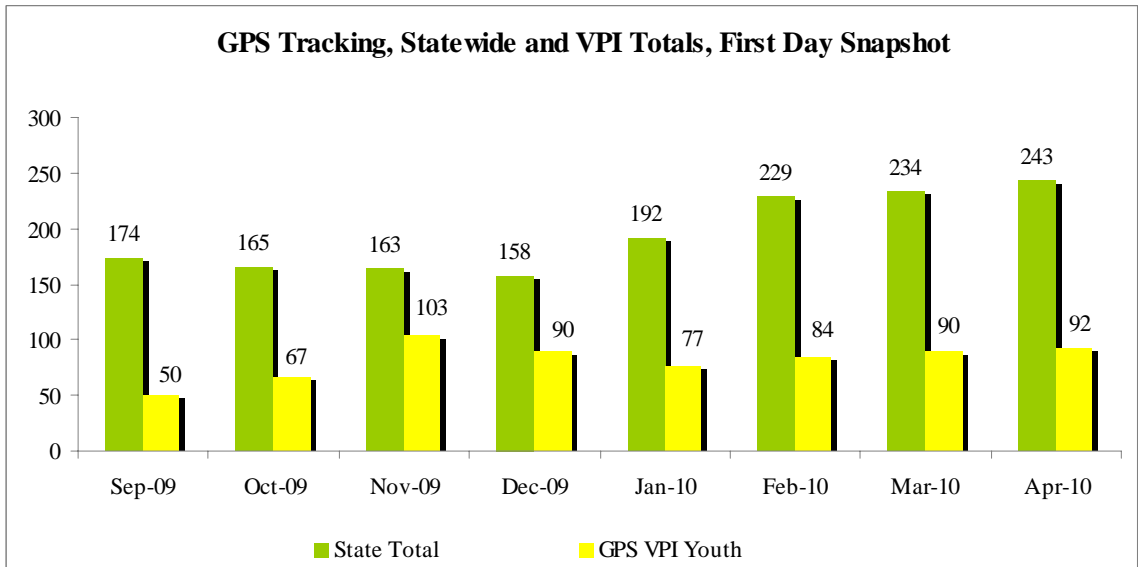

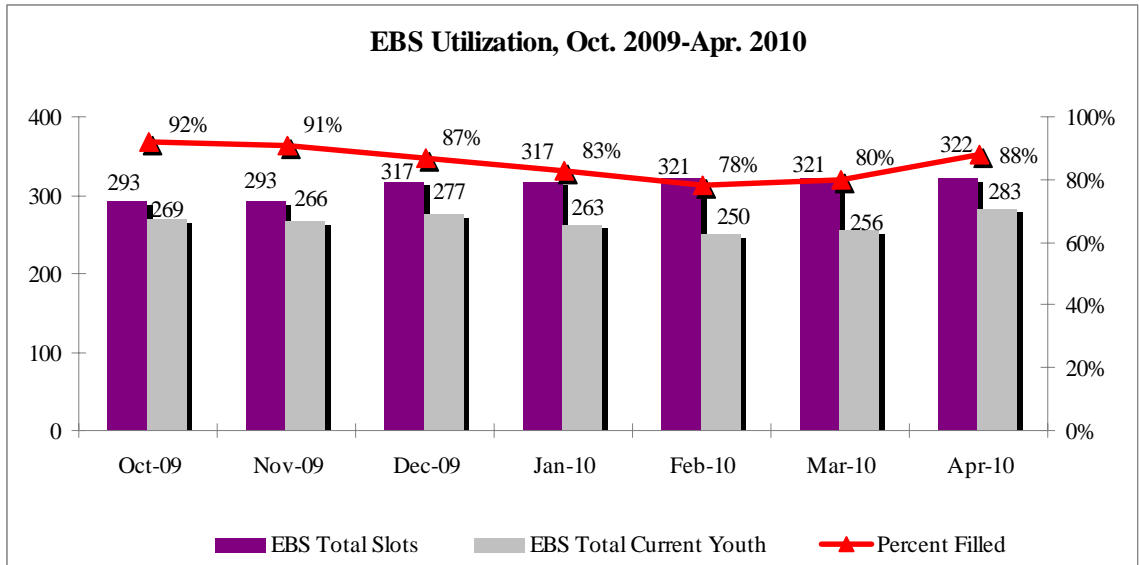
Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on April 9, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **Follow-up Items.** DJS began the meeting by discussing the following topics: MSDE assuming responsibility of the Western Maryland Children's Center in July of this year, parental refusals ie. parents refusing their children after they have been released from detention, and the dedication of a school library at Cheltenham honoring Hannah Wheeling.
- **GPS.** GPS use is at its highest point and DJS discussed utilization in terms of VPI youth. DJS also stated that the protocols, in conjunction with DPSCS, to place units on youth being released from adult detention will be finalized in the coming weeks.



- **Evidence-Based Services.** DJS discussed the expansion of Evidence-Based Services and that they are still on schedule to have all programs at full capacity by June of this year. DJS also discussed the increase in utilization in March and they see the rates rising in the coming months as well.



- Police Reports.** DJS discussed the fact that they are working with local jurisdictions to see what can be done to shorten the time it takes police reports to reach respective local DJS offices.
