

Meeting Summary

Agency: DJS

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on June 4, 2010. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **DJS- MVA ID Card Partnership.** DJS was asked to provide an update on the finalization of the MOU agreement between DJS and MVA to provide ID cards for DJS youth involved in the CORPS program; a new DJS initiative focused on improving re-entry outcomes for up to 400 Baltimore City youth, primarily through targeted employment readiness and school retention programs and incentives. DJS reported that the MVA AG's office had signed an agreement and it is in their interoffice procurement office which is responsible for the agreement. Once DJS' MVA point person received the document, they would forward it to DJS for the Secretary's signature.
- **CRIPA Update.** DJS provided a CRIPA update and was asked to provide a timeline from the Department of Justice as to when the BCJJC placement would be completely clear from federal oversight.
- **VPI Outcomes.** Dr. Richard Berk from the University of Pennsylvania joined the StateStat meeting and discussed gathering data from DJS and evaluating the VPI program. DJS will work with Dr. Berk to determine outcomes as well as overall performance of the program.
