

## Meeting Summary

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the MSP Stat on January 21, 2011. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor's Delivery Unit (GDU).

### Follow Up

- **Carroll County.** MSP began the meeting by stating that they would be in the process of withdrawing from a resident trooper program in Carroll County which will be effective July 1<sup>st</sup>. The positions will be taken over by the Sheriff's Office in Carroll County.

### Warrants

- **CARFTF Warrant Service** (GDU Goal Item IV). The charts below highlight warrant service efforts by the MSP team on the Prince George's County CARFTF task force through November 2010. During the warrant discussion with MSP, MSP was asked to elaborate on their current class of recruits; hence giving the panel an idea of how many troopers would be active in the coming months.

The panel also asked MSP to discuss efforts that are being undertaken in Prince George's County that address the significant rate of murders that took place at the beginning of this calendar year. MSP discussed the fact that more resources were being deployed in the county and that they felt that the homicide rates would stabilize. Also, once the homicide rates stabilizes, that would correlate into more warrants being served.
