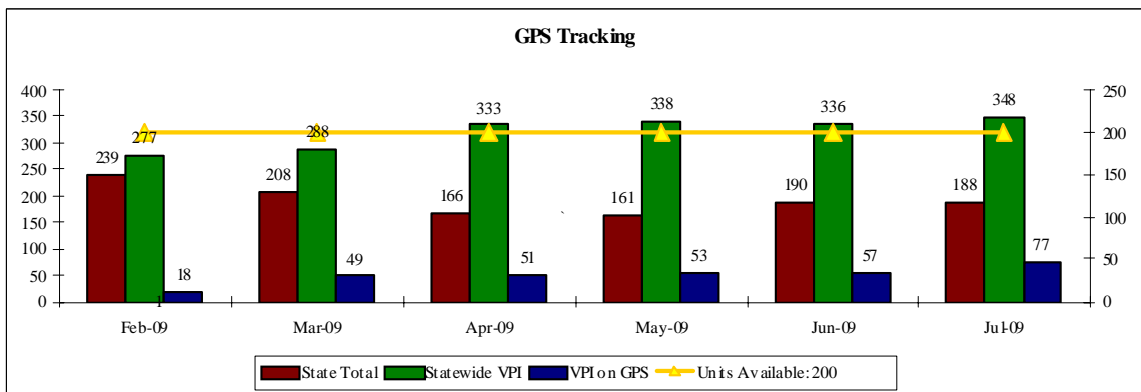

Following is a summary of issues discussed at the DJS Stat on July 31, 2009. Analysis is provided by StateStat and the Governor’s Delivery Unit (GDU).

General Discussion

- **The Sharing of School Records.** DJS addressed their progress in reference to exchanging truancy and attendance data with local school systems and DJS reported that they still expect to conduct initial meetings with the local school system (LSS) in all 24 jurisdictions by the first week of September (14 have been completed). The main problem that still remains an issue for many jurisdictions is confidentiality. However, the number of jurisdictions that are complying is on the rise and DJS is still in talks with others to work out an agreement.
- **GPS Tracking.** DJS reported that the criteria for placement of youth on GPS is: VPI youth-Level One and sanctions for non-VPI youth, Court Orders that specifically request GPS, Court Orders with specific language that reference public safety being compromised (i.e., the Court has determined that efforts to work with the respondent in the community have failed to stop the respondent from committing additional offenses which compromise the safety and welfare of the child and community), and youth who have a history of failing the Community Detention program



Update on GDU Items

- **GDU Dashboard.** GDU recently had a meeting with DJS about populating the “Dashboard” that GDU has created for the purpose of capturing the status of key

departmental projects related to the GDU Violent Crime Reduction goals. DJS will submit an updated dashboard in advance of the next StateStat meeting.
